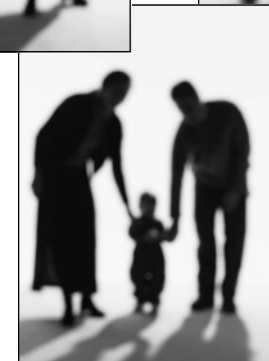

### **What is the South Warren Family Resource Network (SWFRN)?**

SWFRN is a community collaborative of supportive social services agencies and community representatives who assist families from the South Warren community.

### **Our Mission**

To strengthen and empower South Warren Families through prevention and intervention.

### **Guiding Principles**

The members of SWFRN partner for the purpose of protecting children and supporting families by honoring the following guiding principles:

- All children deserve a family
- All families need the support of their community
- DHS, services providers, and neighborhoods need each other to support families

### **Who is eligible for our services?**

- Any Warren resident that needs information and/or referrals for supportive services
- Any Warren family member that has involvement with Macomb County Children’s Protective Services or Foster Care
- Anyone who resides in Warren with custody of a child that is involved with Macomb County Children’s Protective Services or Foster Care
- Foster parents, adoptive parents and relative caregivers that live in Warren

### **How can we help you?**

- Provide ongoing neighborhood support to assist you and your family
- Identify services and provide referrals to complete your Parent/Agency Agreement
- Assist you in Team Decision Making Meetings with Children’s Protective Services or Foster Care
- Assist in arranging neighborhood visitation for children that are in Foster Care
- Individuals that are interested in becoming foster parents that live in Warren

### **How do we help foster parents, adoptive parents and relative caregivers?**

- Monthly support groups
- Free events and recreational opportunities for children and families
- Provide supportive services and community referrals
- Bi-monthly newsletter containing informational articles, listings of upcoming community events and new resources available.

### **How do we help prospective foster parents?**

- Referrals to pre-service training and licensing
- Assistance with questions through the licensing process
- Assistance with minor home repairs to meet licensing requirements
